In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act prohibiting certain termination and cancellation fees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 25C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new section:-
- 3 Section 9. (a) Subject to federal law and regulation, no provider of telephone, cellular
- 4 telephone, television, internet, energy, or water services shall impose a fee for termination or
- 5 early cancellation of a service contract in the event the customer has deceased before the end of
- 6 such contract.
- 7 (b) Every violation of this section shall be punishable by a civil penalty not to exceed one
- 8 thousand dollars.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
