An Act authorizing an ordinance amending chapter11, article II, division 2 entitled city treasurer of the city code of the city of Peabody.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION ONE: That Chapter 11 Finance, Article II Officers, Division 2, entitled “City  
2 Treasurer” of the Code of the City of Peabody is hereby amended as follows:

3 Section 11-34 Investments

4 “The City of Peabody adopts Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 203C, Prudent  
5 Investor Rule. This adoption is limited to the use of Standard and Poor’s top 100 stocks only.”

6 SECTION TWO: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby  
7 repealed.

8 SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
