In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act enhancing school district transportation safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 7A of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 47, the following paragraph:-

3 “Notwithstanding subsection (a) a school district may apply to the department for
4 reimbursement of transportation costs incurred by said district for transporting a student who
5 resides less than one and one-half miles from the school if the route that said student would
6 otherwise travel does not include access to a pedestrian sidewalk, or has a documented history of
7 vehicular accidents.”

8 SECTION 2. The department shall promulgate regulations to effectuate this section.
