The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act to allow all soccer players to wear the Full90 head guard in high school sports..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All Soccer Players both men and women will be allowed to wear the
2 full90 head guard in high school sports.

3 SECTION 2. All soccer players in junior and senior high school and vocational schools
4 will be allowed to wear the Full90 head guard during the soccer season.

5 SECTION 3. The Full90 head guard will be paid for by a state and federal grant.

6 SECTION 4. The Full90 head guard will prevent concussions in soccer every year
7 during the soccer season and will save taxpayers money under Medicaid every year.
