The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act establishing speed limits on portions of Route 28 and Chickatawbut Road in the town of Milton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, or any
- 2 other general or special law to the contrary, the General Court (1) shall establish a motor vehicle
- 3 speed limit of 25 miles per hour for the approaches to the intersection of Route 28 (a state
- 4 highway) and Chickatawbut Road (a Department of Conservation and Recreation park road) in
- 5 Milton and for the intersection itself and (2) require that posting of this speed limit be made by
- 6 signage installed in such places as deemed necessary or appropriate by the Massachusetts
- 7 Department of Transportation with respect to the state highway and the Department of
- 8 Conservation and Recreation with respect to the park road.

- 9 SECTION 2. The Department of Transportation and the Department of Conservation and
- Recreation shall take all actions necessary to implement the establishment of such speed limit.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
