**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to kosher food signage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 156 of chapter 94 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (f) the following subsection:-
3 (f ½) If the certification of a person, firm, association or corporation selling food or food
4 products advertised or represented to be kosher, kosher for Passover, pareve or as having been
5 prepared in accordance with Orthodox Jewish religious standards which it has manufactured,
6 distilled, produced, processed or packed is suspended or terminated by the certifying authority,
7 the person, firm, association or corporation shall display a sign on the door or window or
8 anywhere in front of the place of business stating “Kosher Certification Revoked” in a size
9 which will call such fact to the reader's attention or in a size that the attorney general may specify
10 by regulation.
