The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act clarifying municipal authority regarding cash sureties.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 127I of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a municipality may, by
- 4 ordinance or by-law, require an entity to provide a cash surety in an amount not to exceed
- 5 \$10,000 on vacant property that the entity has the lawful ability to enter upon and control when
- 6 that entity is foreclosing or has foreclosed upon the property.
