An Act amending Chapter 28 of the Acts of 2001.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law, city charter  
2 provision or local ordinance to the contrary, Chapter 28 of the Acts of 2001 is hereby amended  
3 by striking section 6 in its entirety.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
