1           *Ordered*, That by the authority of article IV of section II of chapter I of the Constitution,  
2 the Senate declares that, by reason of the resignation of Viriato M. deMacedo as senator from the  
3 Plymouth and Barnstable district, the office of senator from the Plymouth and Barnstable district  
4 is vacant. By the authority of article XXIV of the Amendments to the Constitution, the Senate  
5 directs the president of the Senate to issue a precept setting forth March 3, 2020, as the day for  
6 holding an election to fill the vacancy in the Plymouth and Barnstable district, comprising of the  
7 towns of Kingston, Pembroke and Plymouth in the county of Plymouth; and the towns of  
8 Bourne, Falmouth and Sandwich in the county of Barnstable.
