An Act protecting dogs at boarding kennels and daycare facilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by adding after Section 174F, the following new section:-
- 3 174G. The Department shall promulgate rules and regulations for boarding kennels and
- 4 daycare facilities for dogs, including home-based kennels and daycare facilities, including, but
- 5 not limited to staff to dog ratios, group sizes and supervision, minimum housing and care
- 6 requirements, indoor and outdoor physical facility requirements, dog handling, insurance, and
- 7 penalties for violation thereof.
