An Act establishing August 31st as Overdose Awareness Day in the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by adding the following section:-

3 Section 16A. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the thirty-
4 first day of August as Overdose Awareness Day, and recommending that said day be observed in
5 an appropriate manner by the people.
