An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Guerda Henry, an employee of the Department of Public Health.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department of Public  
2 Health shall establish a sick leave bank for Guerda Henry, an employee of the department. Any  
3 employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days  
4 to the sick leave bank for use by Guerda Henry. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for  
5 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave  
6 bank as determined by the department. Whenever Guerda Henry terminates employment with the  
7 department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank  
8 shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
