An Act relative to vocational school transportation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 74 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:-

3           A municipality, wherein a person resides who is admitted to a day school in another  
4 municipality under this section, may, through its school committee, provide for the transportation  
5 of such a person.

6           SECTION 2. Section 8A of said chapter 74 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is  
7 hereby repealed.
