Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1P of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 9, after the words "other similar
- 3 initiatives" the following new language:- "and the development of skills to access, analyze and
- 4 evaluate written and digital media as it relates to physical and emotional health, including but not
- 5 limited to how media affects physical and emotional health, social relationships, and body-
- 6 image".
