An Act authorizing the town of Tewksbury to change the name of its Board of Selectmen to Select Board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The charter of the town of Tewksbury, which is on file in the office of the  
2           archivist of the commonwealth, as provided in section 12 of chapter 43B of the General Laws, is  
3           hereby amended by replacing the terms “board of selectmen”, “board” or “selectmen”, appearing  
4           in a context where reference is made to the entire board of selectmen, with the following term:-  
5           select board.

6           SECTION 2. Said charter is hereby further amended to replace any reference to  
7           individual members of the board of selectmen with the following term:- select board member.

8           SECTION 3. Said charter is hereby further amendment to replace and reference to the  
9           chairman with the following term:- chair.

10          SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
