## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to local opt-in for permanent outdoor dining.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding chapter 40A of the general laws or any special permit, variance or any 2 other general or special law to the contrary, a city or town may approve requests for expansion of 3 outdoor table service or extensions of earlier granted approvals, including a local licensing 4 authority ("LLA") approving a request for a change description of licensed premises for the 5 purpose of permitting outdoor alcohol and or service. For the purposes of this section "outdoor 6 table service" shall mean restaurant service that includes food prepared on-site and under food 7 permits issued by municipal authorities pursuant to 105 CMR 590.00 that is served to seated 8 diners outside the restaurant building envelop, whether on a sidewalk, patio, deck, lawn, parking 9 area, or other outdoor space.
