An Act relative to rabies and other vaccination requirements and licensing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 145B of chapter 140 as appearing in the 2018 official edition is  
2 hereby amended by inserting in line 39 after the word “reasons” the following:- “and a titer test,  
3 in the case of these medical exemptions, may be administered to assist in determining the need  
4 for the vaccination;”
