An Act designating a certain playground on the Esplanade in the city of Boston as the Gronk Playground.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The former Charlesbank Playground located on the Esplanade in the city of  
2 Boston shall be designated and known as “Gronk Playground” in recognition of the time and  
3 resources the Gronk Nation Youth Foundation has dedicated to inspiring youth to reach their  
4 maximum potential through sports, education, community and fitness.

5           SECTION 2. After consultation with the department of conservation and recreation, the  
6 Esplanade Association may erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in  
7 compliance with the standards of the department.
