In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to student assessment data.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 89 in Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, 2 is hereby amended by striking out, starting in line 199, the words "overall student performance 3 on the statewide assessment system approved by the board under section 1I of chapter 69" and 4 inserting in place thereof the following words:- "student growth"; and by striking out, starting in 5 line 201, the words "based on student performance data collected pursuant to section 1I," and 6 inserting in place thereof the following word:- "that"; and by striking out, in line 203, the words 7 "statewide student performance" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- "student 8 growth".
