An Act expanding access to higher education tuition and fee waivers for adopted foster children..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 19 of chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 44, the word “state-supported”.

3           SECTION 2. Section 19 of chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
4 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “provide” in line 58 the following  
5 word:- full.
