An Act protecting public higher education student information.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 66 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding a new section:
- 3 Section 22. Public institutions of higher education, as set forth in section 5 of chapter
- 4 15A, and municipally owned institutions of higher education, shall not be required to produce
- 5 education records, including information designated by the public institution of higher education
- 6 as directory information, as defined under the Family Educational and Privacy Rights Act, 20
- 7 U.S.C. section 1232 (g). This section shall not apply to requests from federal, state, or municipal
- 8 agencies.
