The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act Authorizing Performance-Based Education Funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 73 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding, after Section 12 thereof, 2 the following new section:
- 3 Section 12A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or regulation to the contrary,
- 4 not less than twenty-five percent of any sums appropriated by the general court for the
- 5 maintenance, operation and support of each state university and community college shall be
- 6 based on performance criteria developed by the Secretary of Education, which shall include but
- 7 not be limited to, the retention and successful completion of courses of study, as evidenced by
- 8 graduation, certification or other similar documentation, and rates or measures of the academic
- 9 achievement of students.
