The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act commissioning a study of vocational education.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of elementary and secondary education shall conduct a study to evaluate
- 2 the availability of high quality, chapter 74-approved vocational education programs in all regions
- 3 of the Commonwealth. The study shall consider whether students in all municipalities and school
- 4 districts have reasonable access to vocational programs.
- 5 If the department determines that access to vocational education is inadequate, the
- 6 department, in consultation with the Massachusetts school building authority, shall submit a
- 7 report to the clerks of the house and senate detailing the areas in which access is inadequate and
- 8 an estimate of the cost of establishing new vocational programs to meet the unmet demand.
