## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to civics education.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all school districts shall
- 2 submit to the Joint Committee on Education, the House and Senate Committee on Ways and
- 3 Means, and the Clerks of the House and the Senate their plans to implement a culturally
- 4 competent civics education curriculum including but not limited to the history and contributions
- of: women, people of color, immigrants, the civil rights movement, the women's suffrage
- 6 movement, the abolitionist movement, native peoples, religious minorities, the LGBT
- 7 community, veterans, and other underrepresented groups in history, by June 30, 2022
