AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE ATTRACTING EXCELLENCE TO TEACHING PROGRAMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 19A of chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out subsection (2) in its entirety.

3           SECTION 2. Subsection (3) of section 19A of said chapter 15A is hereby amended in  
4 line 25 by striking out, in line 25, the words "forty-eight" and inserting in place thereof the  
5 words:- ninety-six.
