### AN ACT RELATIVE TO SPECIAL EDUCATION BUDGETS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

| 1 | SECTION 1. Recognizing that school districts and municipalities are unable to                      |

| 4 | extraordinary and unanticipated special education cost, the Commonwealth will devise an            |
| 5 | insurance policy for municipalities in school districts which will allow them to be reimbursed for |
| 6 | special education costs that exceed 25% of the dollar amount obtained by the formula below:        |

| 7 | The average special education expenditures for the commonwealth over the last three years,         |
| 8 | divided by the average number of public school students in the commonwealth over the last three    |
| 9 | years, multiplied by the number of students in a particular school district or municipality.       |
