Senate, November 21, 2024 - Text of the Senate amendment (Senator Gomez) to the House Bill increasing the age limit for the appointment of special police officers in the city of Springfield (House, No. 4822).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)

1 SECTION 1. Special police officers in the city of Springfield appointed pursuant to
2 chapter 133 of the acts of 2018 shall not be subject to the same maximum age restrictions applied
3 to regular police officers in the city of Springfield under chapter 32 of the General Laws;
4 provided, however, that such special police officers appointed pursuant to said chapter 133 shall
5 be subject to a maximum age restriction of 70 years of age.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
