An Act to establish the Massachusetts National Guard Museum in Salem.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 33 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 140. There shall be a Massachusetts National Guard museum in the city of
- 3 Salem, the birthplace of the national guard pursuant to section 60 of chapter 2; provided, that
- 4 said museum shall be the official military museum for the commonwealth.
