Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 54A of chapter 71 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "eleven C", in line 3, the

- 4 , or a licensed athletic trainer, who has completed the annual head injury safety training,
- 5 as required by 105 CMR 201.007,

7 SECTION 2. Said section 54A of said chapter 71 is hereby further amended by inserting

- 8 at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-
- A licensed athletic trainer shall be employed by a superintendent or school committee at
- every high school in the commonwealth offering interscholastic athletic activities.
