An Act to special education transportation reimbursement from 75% to 90%.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 5A of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in subsection (c) the words “and  
3 transportation”.

4           SECTION 2: Section 5A of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “threshold.” , the following:  
6 Transportation costs shall be reimbursed at 90%.
