**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to adjusting approved costs threshold.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5A of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in subsection (a), after “Approved Costs Threshold”,
- 3 the number “\$45,793”, and inserting in place thereof the number “\$37,120”
