By Mr. Tarr, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 340) of Bruce E. Tarr, Ann-Margaret Ferrante and Richard J. Ross for legislation relative to residency requirements for voting. Election Laws.

### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act on strengthening and clarifying residency requirements for the purpose of voting .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the secretary of

- 2 the commonwealth shall conduct a study to review existing laws in regards to residency
- 3 requirements for purposes of voting. Secretary shall make any recommendations to strengthen
- 4 and clarify residency requirements as they pertain to eligibility for voting in municipal, state, and
- 5 federal elections and participation in town meetings, particularly so as to ensure for the
- 6 maximum extent possible, that such requirements are clear, easily understood, and enforceable in
- 7 an efficient manner. Secretary shall submit the study and recommendations to the clerks of the
- 8 senate and house and to the Joint Committee on Election Laws by September 30, 2013.
