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In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act regarding home care cost sharing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 4A of Chapter 19A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the first sentence of the first paragraph and
3	inserting in place thereof, the following sentence:
4	"If a consumer who is otherwise eligible for home care services has income which is
5	within the range established in the home care cost sharing schedule as authorized by the
6	executive office of elder affairs, the consumer shall make a co-payment in accordance with the
7	schedule set forth in the financial eligibility guidelines in effect during the consumer's initial
8	determination or redetermination of financial eligibility."
