*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 21E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "located", in line 2, the following  
3 words:-, or a majority of the board of selectmen in a town, or a majority of the city council and  
4 mayor in a city subject to the city charter, in which a site is located,
