An Act relative to unfunded election audits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 109A of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new section:-
3 (k) This section shall be contingent upon state appropriation.
