In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to campaign finance during special elections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 55 in the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following new definition after the first
- 3 definition:-
- 4 "Calendar Year", any year beginning on January 1st and ending December 31st. There
- 5 shall be a special election exemption for campaign contributions if a special election and a
- 6 general election occur within the same calendar year. Contributions may not exceed the defined
- 7 limits set forth in this chapter, for each election cycle during said calendar year.
