An Act relative to candidate reporting requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 18 of Chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 21, by inserting before the word ‘eighth’ the  
3   following:- “fiftieth day preceding a primary, the”

4           SECTION 2. Section 18 of Chapter 55 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
5   amended in in line 24, by striking the word “eighth” and inserting in place thereof the following  
6   word:- “fifteenth”
