An Act to allow political parties to permit voters enrolled in other parties to vote in their primaries.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Title VIII. Chapter 53, Section 38 is hereby amended by adding after the following  
2 words:

3 "No voter enrolled under this section or section thirty-seven shall be allowed to receive  
4 the ballot of any political party except that in which he is so enrolled..."

5 unless the state committee of a political party submits a statement to the Secretary  
6 allowing voters enrolled in other, specified parties other than its own.
