### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

#### AN ACT RELATIVE TO FLEXIBLE RATE OPTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. As defined under section 1 of said chapter 1760, a carrier is permitted to
- 2 enter into a multi-year agreement with an employer concerning the purchase of employer-
- 3 sponsored health insurance coverage as long as such an agreement comprises no more than 10%
- 4 of a carrier's total membership or 10 % of accounts in force.
- 5 **SECTION 2.** All agreements between carriers and employers for the purchase of
- 6 employer-sponsored health insurance coverage are subject to the authority of the division of
- 7 insurance concerning carriers, including but not limited to chapter 175; a nonprofit hospital
- 8 service corporation organized under <u>chapter 176A</u>; a nonprofit medical service corporation
- 9 organized under <u>chapter 176B</u>; a health maintenance organization organized under <u>chapter 176G</u>;
- and an organization entering into a preferred provider arrangement under <u>chapter 176I</u>, but not
- including an employer purchasing coverage or acting on behalf of its employees or the
- employees of one or more subsidiaries or affiliated corporations of the employer.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
