An Act designating a certain park in the city of Cambridge as Richard McKinnon park.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to designate forthwith a certain park in the city of Cambridge, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of  
2 conservation and recreation shall change the name of North Point Park, a park on the Charles  
3 River Reservation in the city of Cambridge, to Richard McKinnon Park in recognition of years of  
4 service developing landscapes throughout Cambridge, including the aforementioned North Point  
5 Park. The department shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the name.
