**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**  
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An Act to make habilitative services available to the children of the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 25 of chapter 32A of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following definitions:

3 “Developmental delay”, a disability in a person diagnosed by licensed physician which  
4 results in a delay in attaining the capacity to achieve age appropriate physical, intellectual,  
5 communicative, emotional, and social functioning within the person's environment

6 “Treatment of developmental delay” includes the following care when prescribed,  
7 provided or ordered by a licensed physician or a licensed psychologist who determines the care
