Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 255C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "mail", in line 23, the following

3 words:- any written notice of cancellation initated by the insurance company for any additional

4 premium shall be sent to the finance company no later than twenty days prior to the effective day

5 of cancellation;

and is further amended by inserting, after the word "agreement", in line 29, the following
words:- to an agent of the insurer or premium finance agency;

8 SECTION 2. Said section 21 of said chapter 255c is hereby further amended by deleting9 the last sentence.
