In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to the effect of comprehensive insurance claims.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended as follows:-
- 3 (a) by striking out, in lines 165 through 167, the words "and based on 4 or more
- 4 comprehensive claims totalling \$2,000 or more unless fire, theft, comprehensive and collision

5 coverages are not purchased by the insured;"

- 6 (b) by striking out, in lines 169 through 171, the words "In establishing the 4 or more
- 7 comprehensive claims totalling \$2,000 or more, claims for damages caused by acts of God shall

8 be excluded."

9 (c) by striking out, in lines 184 through 187, the words "and based on 4 or more 10 comprehensive claims totalling \$2,000 or more unless fire, theft, comprehensive and collision 11 coverages are not purchased by the insured;"

(d) by striking out, in lines 205 through 207, the words "or 4 or more comprehensive
claims totalling \$2,000 or more unless fire, theft, comprehensive and collision coverages are not
purchased by the insured."
