12	SECTION 3. Section 21 of Chapter 1760 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
13	Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:
14	(f) The Commissioner shall annually make all information submitted to the Division
15	pursuant to the provisions of subsections (a) to (e) publicly available on a website in an easily
16	readable and understandable format.

SECTION 4. The division of insurance shall implement the provisions of this Act for alldata submitted 90 days after the effective date.
