An Act providing tuition to children of state employees killed on duty..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 15A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2 section 19D, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, the following section:

3 Section 19F. A person who was a minor child of a state employee who as the result of an  
4 accident while in the performance of his duties was killed or sustained injuries which resulted in  
5 his death; or while in the performance of his duties and as a result of an assault on his person was  
6 killed or sustained injuries which resulted in his death, shall be entitled to a scholarship equal to  
7 the full cost of tuition, room and board upon acceptance to a state college or university.
