Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of section 3 of Chapter 159A1/2 of the General Laws is

- 3 (iv) that the transportation network company disclose to riders the fare or fare calculation
- 4 method on its website or within the online application.

- 6 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the words "customer service hotline" the
- 7 following words:- or online system
- 8 SECTION 3. Clause (viii) of subsection (c) of section 3 of Chapter 159A1/2 of the
- 9 General Laws is hereby further amended by inserting after the words "hotline number" the
- 10 following words:- or link to the online system
- SECTION 4. Section 2 of Chapter 159A1/2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- striking out subsection (e) and replacing with the following:-

- (e) A transportation network company shall establish and implement a written policy
- capping dynamic pricing during a federal or a governor-declared state of emergency.
