An Act to allow students access to prescription cannabis.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 2 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting, after the word “facility”, in line 41, the following:-

3           “; provided, however, that this paragraph shall not apply to possession or consumption of  
4 medical use marijuana as defined in chapter 94I; or (4) authorize the possession or consumption  
5 of marijuana or marijuana accessories”.
