In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to physician assistants.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of Chapter 176S of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "commission" in line 1, the following
- words "in addition to the Secretary of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services".
- 4 Section 2 of Chapter 176S of the General Laws, as so appearing, is further amended by
- 5 inserting after the word "carriers" in line 2, the following words "including the medical
- 6 assistance program administered by the office of Medicaid pursuant to Chapter 118E and in
- 7 accordance with Title XIX of the Social Security Act or any successor statute.
- 8 Section 8 of Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as so appearing, is amended by adding
- 9 the following paragraph to subsection  $e^{1/2}$  –

10 "A participating provider physician assistant practicing within the scope of such physician's license, including all regulations requiring collaboration with or supervision by a physician under section 9E of Chapter 112, shall be considered qualified within this Chapter's definition of primary care provider to an insured."

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
