AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROTECTING AGAINST THE DISPLACEMENT OF CURRENT
EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (B) of said section 2 of said chapter 18 of the General Laws, as amended
2 by Chapter 5 of the Acts of 1995, is hereby amended by inserting the following new clause:-

3 (j) not delegate to other than to its own employees the administration, determination of eligibility,
4 or supervision of the state plan which are currently being performed by department employees.
