An Act relative to the redetermination of alimony.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, upon an
- 2 action for modification of a judgment for alimony based on a change of circumstances, the court
- 3 may consider facts relative to the change of circumstances without regard to the date the facts
- 4 arose, either before or after the changed circumstances were brought to the attention of the court.
